Organizational Overview

It was on a trip to Haiti that I first met Father Rick Frechette, an American doctor and community organizer who'd been working in the slums of Port-au-Prince for over two decades. He and his small team run the St. Luke Foundation, and have built an orphanage, medical clinics, street schools, and a pediatric hospital that is the only free hospital serving the children of one of the largest slums in the Western Hemisphere. They have done all this with little support and a lot of

imagination, succeeding where many bigger and better-funded organizations have failed, largely by empowering the people with whom they work.

Thanks to their efforts, families in the slums have clean water to drink, children can look forward to a meal every day, and people in some of the poorest communities in the world have the opportunity to become self-sufficient through high-quality education.

Artists for Peace and Justice is dedicated to helping Father Rick and the St. Luke Foundation achieve their goals. We give grants for specific projects, where every penny has an impact, and every dollar goes to help the children of Haiti.

In the spring of 2010, we noticed the need in Haiti for secondary education and committed to building the first free secondary school to serve the poorest communities in Haiti. By October, we welcomed the inaugural class of 400 students. When construction on the school is complete, it will provide full scholarships — including tuition, uniforms, and nutritious meals — to approximately 3,000 students every year. Together with our implementing partners, the St. Luke Foundation, we are working as hard as possible to make sure our dream becomes a reality.

On behalf of the Board of Artists for Peace and Justice, thank you for your support. It is because of you that we are able to make a difference in the lives of the children of Haiti.

HAITI:

BEFORE THE EARTHQUAKE

Haiti was the poorest nation in the Western hemisphere.

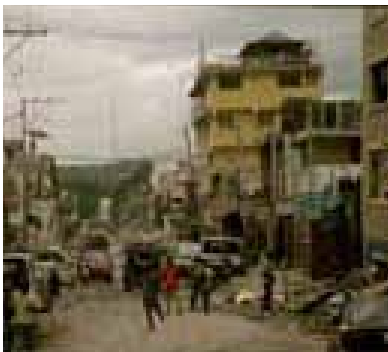
- 55% of the population were living in extreme poverty.
- 1.2 million children were living in the slums and extremely vulnerable to violence, exploitation and abuse.
- Only 50% of Haitians had access to clean drinking water.
- 1.9 million people did not have enough food to eat.

HAITI:

THE AFTERMATH

On January 12, 2010, a 7.0 magnitude earthquake struck Haiti, devastating the capital of Port-au-Prince and the surrounding areas.

- **Over 220,000 Haitians were killed and 300,000 more were injured.**
- **87% of schools in Port-au-Prince were destroyed.**
- **Over 1 million people are still living in tent camps.**
- **The cholera epidemic has claimed over 6,000 lives to date.**

OUR PROGRAMS

Our immediate goal is to serve children and their families in the poorest communities in Haiti by supporting programs in education, health and dignity.

APJ Programs



EDUCATION

Over 80% of Haitian youth drop out of school after 6th grade because they can't afford to continue their education. To address this need, Artists for Peace and Justice is building the Academy for Peace and Justice, the first free secondary school to serve the very poor in Haiti. At full capacity, the school will provide a free high-quality education to approximately 3,000 students every year.



DIGNITY

Less than 2/3 of Haiti's population have formal jobs. To address this need, Artists for Peace and Justice is committed to supporting projects that provide jobs to the local community. The construction of the Academy for Peace and Justice created dozens of jobs for the local community, and over 40 Haitians work at the Academy full-time as teachers and administrators.



HEALTH

Only 1 in 10,000 Haitians has access to a physician. To address this need, Artists for Peace and Justice supports the health initiatives of the St. Luke Foundation, funding surgeries at St. Damien's Children's hospital and the St. Philomena Cholera Hydration Center. With APJ's support, the cholera center was constructed just 36 hours after the epidemic hit.

St. Luke Foundation

The St. Luke Foundation is the grassroots organization run by Father Rick Frechette that has been working on the ground in Haiti for over 20 years. St. Luke runs extensive programs in both health and education, saving thousands of lives every year and educating thousands more in its network of 29 primary schools. APJ is lucky to have St. Luke as our implementing partner on the ground in Haiti. St. Luke enables APJ to help make a difference in Haiti and we are grateful to work by their side.



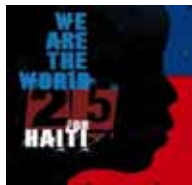
Francesca Rava Foundation and NPH Italia

The facilities will include practice rooms, a performance theater and a recording studio for the students and the community to learn and benefit from music and the arts.

Dear friends
of Artists for Peace and Justice,

My name is Antoine Edy. I am the Headmaster of the Academy for Peace and Justice in Port Au Prince.

When the earthquake came in January of 2010 many of the schools of the capital collapsed, including the school where I was headmaster. As a country we were devastated. Haiti has always struggled to have enough schools to serve her children and after the earthquake we really suffered.

I began working with Artists for Peace and Justice and St Luc when the school was just an empty field. We worked hard to open on time and it was with great excitement that we opened our doors to nearly 400 children in October 2010. The Academy for Peace and Justice is a free secondary school for Haiti's very poor. In a country where secondary education is nearly non-existent, and children often turn to the streets after primary school due to lack of options, I am deeply proud of our school. We continue to grow with your amazing support.

We will open the doors of our new building in late September 2011 and welcome a new class to learn. Today is the last day of school and the students are taking their final exams. We have come a long way and as I look out over the courtyard it brings me great joy to see our staff and teachers working so hard to make sure that each student passes and will never again get left behind. Our school is thriving because of you and your support and I want to thank you for that on behalf of the students, staff and administration.

We have opened our school in the face of the greatest of challenges. We have sweat and toiled for this beacon of hope and the road has been difficult. We will continue to grow as our students grow each day bringing new joy and knowledge. From the rubble grows hope and light from the dark. Thank you.

January 12

An earthquake registering a magnitude of 7.0 hits 16 miles west of Port-au-Prince, Haiti's capital. Death toll estimates range anywhere from approximately 50,000 up to 315,000 and homeless figures reach 1 million.

January 21

AP J arrives in Haiti with doctors, medicine and funding for St Luke's. AP J immediately saves 18 lives through arranging international medevac for 18 spinal cord injury victims. A complete survey of site damages is conducted and a strategic reconstruction plan is born.

January 24

Paul and Deborah Haggis host an AP J benefit brunch at their home in Santa Monica. The brunch **raises \$4.5 M** in pledges and commitments over 5 years.



January 25

AP J begins immediate support of the **St. Luke Family Hospital**, which provides free medical care to the poorest and most vulnerable people in Port-au-Prince. With AP J's support, St. Luke has provided 500 free surgeries and treated thousands of patients for issues ranging from hernias to dehydration to gunshot wounds.



March 16

Ban Ki Moon notes the UN's revised **emergency appeal for \$1.4 billion in humanitarian assistance** and reconstruction for Haiti is only 49 percent funded so far.

March 23

AP J, Brioni, Paul Haggis, Gerard Butler and Lee Daniels host the Award Season Benefit at Bar Nineteen 12 in Beverly Hills.

March 31

The multi-donor conference in NY commits **nearly \$5.3 billion to the relief and reconstruction efforts.**



April 1

AP J's Board Members visit the future school site, walk the land, and envision the school that will be built there in the future.



April 15

The Interim Haiti Recovery Commission (IHRC) is approved by the government of Haiti to help steer international donations.

April 17

AP J partners with the World Food Program to feed almost 22,000 people every day through the WFP's food donations.



August 16

AP J has partnered with TOMs shoes to distribute thousands of free shoes to the children of Haiti who need protection from the dangerous rubble left behind after the earthquake. The shoes have helped protect the children's feet from cuts, sores and infection.

August 31

The land purchase for the future site of the Academy for Peace and Justice is finalized and the plans for the school are set in motion.



September

More than 1,000 tent camps remain teeming with 1.2 million people across Port-au-Prince. Relocation to longer-term housing is hampered by rubble and land ownership.

October

An additional \$48,000 was donated to help with ongoing care at the Cholera Center.



October 27

In the midst of recovering from the destruction of the earthquake, the people of Haiti were hit with a cholera epidemic that spread through the country and infected thousands. In order to get care to the people who need it, AP J has provided the office space and screening facilities for the Cholera Center at St Damien's Hospital. AP J was also able to secure the donation of many other essentials for the Centre, including tents, cots, water, showers and many of the IVs and medical supplies. Over 5,000 patients have been treated at the center — 50% of whom would have died without immediate treatment.

May 20

AP J heads to the Cannes International Film Festival for a fundraiser co-hosted by Paul Haggis, Russell Crowe and Danielle Spencer. **This event raised over \$150,000.**

June

AP J commits to **building the first free secondary school in Port-au-Prince, the Academy for Peace and Justice.**



September 11

The 'IT' Party at the Toronto International Film Festival is co-hosted by Paul Haggis, James Franco, Maria Bello and Anna Lynne McCord and **raises almost \$100,000.**

October 10

The Academy for Peace and Justice, opened its doors to the inaugural class of **400 grade seven students.** Haiti has the lowest enrollment, completion and literacy rates of any country in the Western Hemisphere with the 6th grade being the standard education level. In the coming years, this groundbreaking school will provide approximately 3,000 students per year from grades 7-13 with the tools and knowledge that will benefit Haiti in the long term. The school will also remove major barriers to education by providing food, clean water and medical care for the students.

November 5

An intimate dinner co-hosted by Susan Sarandon, Gerard Butler, Russell Crowe, Ben Stiller, Adrien Brody, Salman Rushdie, Trudie Styler and Peter Tunney at Millesime in New York City **raises over \$700,000 for AP J.**

November

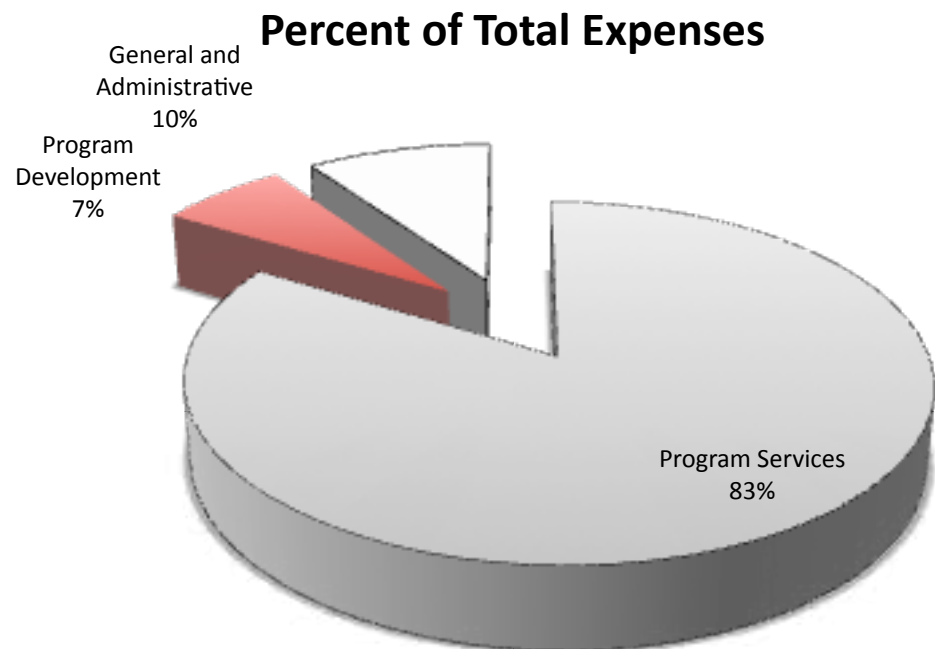
